Internship Summary: The library internship at the Great American Songbook Foundation provides the opportunity to gain familiarity with the breadth of library and archival responsibilities including cataloging and metadata; digital projects; archival arrangement and description; collection development; and outreach and access.

Internship duties and responsibilities will include the following:

- 1. Metadata creation and ingest for a grant-funded digital preservation project of unique audiovisual materials.
- 2. Cataloging collections of published materials using OCLC's Conexion and Libraryworld.
- 3. Maintenance, clean-up, and updating of web-based collection management system.
- 4. Evaluate current materials for deaccession and making recommendations for future additions to the library.

Education/Qualifications:

- 1. Current MLS/MLIS student with 3+ cataloging OR metadata credits*, OR at least 6 months practical cataloging experience.
- 2. Independent, reliable, collaborative worker, comfortable working alone or in a group.
- 3. Excellent oral and written communication skills.

Abilities:

1. Lift boxes weighing up to 30 pounds and move them on a cart.
